What is a Community First Responder (CFR)

Hi, my name is Steve. A lot of you will know me as the paper man , but I am also proud to be one of this area's CFR. We are a group of people who are trained by and controlled by South West Ambulance Service (SWAS). When trained you are asked to respond to calls from SWAS to go to care for people in this area who have for one reason or another have called and asked for an ambulance. We arrive, reassure and comfort the patient and reassure the family or whoever is with them. We then make a series of observations as we have been trained to do, note these down and find out the why, when and how bad the situation. When the crew arrive (the most amazing group of people I have ever meet) you will "handover" to them. You basically give them your observations and what you have learnt from the patient and others. Then it's up to you what you do, wait and see what happens and talk to the family while the crew do their stuff or just say your good byes and leave.

When the Gorran group was set up by Tricia Atkins and her family at a very sad time in their family, seven people from the village formed the group and we all took turns to be "On Call", sadly owing to family and work commitments the group slowly sank to just 2, the lovely Madeline and I. We are now a group of 2, Jerry and me. We need a couple of you to train up and join us. Your "NVQ" qualification training will be done by South West Ambulance Service, you will then be issued with a very smart uniform and then let loose on the neighbourhood.
