Parking and Voluntary One-Way System

As parking is very limited at school we have, for several years, used a voluntary one-way system to try and ease the congestion in the morning and afternoon. The idea is for everyone to come through the village and drop off and pick up children with the school on the left of their cars, then proceed down Crooked Lane back onto the Gorran Road. This should keep a smooth flow of traffic in front of school in one direction. Please remember to park only on the school side of the road - preferably in the lay-by and not to park in front of the school car park entrance. Please also be aware that parking too close to the junction makes visibility poor. I know that parking can be difficult but if everyone continues to be considerate and aware of the importance of the children's safety I am sure that problems will be reduced.
