The Community Speed Watch Scheme (CSW) is an opportunity for residents to play a part in positively influencing driver behavior and reducing speed.

Devon and Cornwall Police and Vision Zero South West facilitate CSW speed monitoring by authorising sites from where monitoring can safely be undertaken, provide equipment and training as well as assist with ongoing support once a CSW group is active in the local community.

The CSW Scheme is educational and advisory letters are sent by Devon and Cornwall Police to the Registered Keepers of any vehicle monitored as speeding by a CSW group warning about the risks of speeding and a request to reduce their speed.
