Cornwall Cricket Board launches Crowdfunder campaign to make cricket fully accessible for people with disabilities

Cornwall Cricket Board has launched an exciting new Crowdfunder campaign to build on the incredible success of Cornwall's first Disability Cricket Team.

The campaign aims to remove financial and practical barriers so that people with disabilities across Cornwall can access competitive cricket, with the right equipment, support and opportunities to develop their skills, represent the county with pride, and be part of a thriving team.

Cornwall Cricket Board provides opportunities for adults and children aged five and above to take part in cricket across the county. From grassroots sessions to competitive teams, the Board is committed to growing cricket and ensuring it is open to everyone.

One of the proudest achievements to date is the creation of Cornwall's first ever Disability Cricket Team. In just their second season, the team has already secured South West League Champion status and national recognition through the BBC Radio Cornwall Make a Difference Awards, demonstrating the extraordinary potential for disability cricket in Cornwall.

For many players, what began as a fun introduction to cricket has now grown into the chance to proudly represent Cornwall and win championships. But for this journey to continue, every player must have access to the right kit, equipment, venues and travel support, regardless of income or background. Head Coach Daniel Tonkin Said: "I cannot express enough how incredibly proud I am of the Super 9s' success this past year, especially as it was only our second season. I'd like to extend my heartfelt thanks to all the players and coaches for their hard work throughout the season. Moving forward, we must continue to explore avenues to enhance our financial security. Our aim is to minimize the financial impact on parents and carers, ensuring continued accessibility for all our team members."

Cornwall Cricket Board Chief Executive Officer Joe Skinner said: "It has been an incredible 2025 season built on the good work carried out by the coaching staff of Cornwall disability cricket team. All those involved, players, parents and staff should be incredibly proud of what they have achieved in such a short space of time. With limited financial support from the National Governing Body, we must make every effort to make the programme financially sustainable so as to maintain the upward trajectory and opportunities we want to provide.

The Crowdfunder will cover essential costs including: Playing kit, bats, pads and gloves for all players, Specialist protective gear tailored to individual needs, Travel to fixtures across the South West (Somerset, Dorset, Hampshire) and Venue hire for training and home matches

By removing financial barriers, the campaign will ensure every player can fully take part and continue developing their cricketing journey.


