3 Start your journey. Find your nearest Beat Box using our paper or digital map and hover your card at the contactless Beat Box until it beeps and flashes. If playing with the app, tap the Beat Box icon on your phone and swipe to collect points.



4 Visit 2 Beat Boxes within an hour and collect 10 points for each Beat Box – this is 20 points for the journey.



5 Carry on your journey. Score 10 points for each extra Box you visit.
